On March 10, 2022, the Board of Education adopted modifications to Policy 1060 Bullying, Cyberbullying, Harassment, or Intimidation and Policy 6080 Sustainability.

Policy 1060 was modified to align the policy to Maryland’s Model Policy to Address Bullying, Harassment, or Intimidation in accordance with Section 7-424.1 of the Education Article in the Annotated Code of Maryland. The title of the policy was changed to Bullying, Cyberbullying, Harassment, and Intimidation.

Policy 6080 Sustainability was modified in accordance with HB0630: Primary and Secondary Education – School District Energy Use – Policy and Study: Requiring each school district to adopt or update a school district energy policy beginning July 1, 2022; specifying the contents of a school district energy policy; encouraging school districts to set targets to increase the school district's use of renewable energy and reduce the school district's greenhouse gas emissions; and requiring that a school district energy policy be posted on the school district's website and updated every 3 years.
