Cell Phone Use While Driving

Howard County Public School System is committed to promoting safety and wellness for its children and employees. The risk associated with the distraction created by using a cell phone while driving is well documented. Please be mindful that the use of any cell phone, including hands-free devices, while driving an HCPSS-owned vehicle or operating a personal vehicle while on school system business is prohibited.

A state law prohibiting the use of a hand-held cell phone while driving became effective on October 1, 2010. The law also bans the use of cell phones at any time while driving for school bus drivers, those under 18, and adults who hold learner's permits.

If it is necessary to make an emergency call while driving, the employee must stop the vehicle in a safe place on the side of the road or in a parking area to make the call. Traffic violations, including the use of cell phones while driving, are the responsibility of the employee and violations may subject an employee to disciplinary action per Board policy.
