Description:

Under the direction of the Black Student Achievement Program's Saturday Math Academy (BSAP SMA) Administrator, facilitates chess instruction that actively engages all HCPSS students in **grades 3 through 5** over a six-week fall session and a six-week spring session. Provides an atmosphere and environment conducive to the intellectual, physical, social and emotional development of individuals to ensure success for every student. Communicates and interacts with students, parents, staff and the BSAP Saturday Math Academy community. Maintains appropriate records and follows required procedures and practices. Monitors appropriate use and care of equipment, materials and facilities.

Position Responsibilities:

- Uses Chess Instruction to develop student-centered lessons that deepen conceptual understanding, provides opportunities for students to engage in collaborative problem solving, productive reasoning and mathematical discourse.
- Develop chess lessons that teach students strategy, tactics, creative thinking, perseverance, and calculated risk-taking.
- Participates in collaborative planning with other chess instructors of the same course, and
 if relevant, assigned academic mentors to design lessons that provide differentiation to
 meet the needs of all students within the classroom to include flexible grouping, as
 needed.
- Facilitates the Spring Chess Tournament
- Facilitates Chess Team Meetings to effectively plan and prepare for the upcoming Saturday Chess Course.
- Attends staff meetings and professional learning opportunities.
- Maintains student attendance records.
- Provides ongoing feedback to students and parents.

Minimum Qualifications:

Maryland State teacher certification in mathematics with applicable endorsements

Experience:

At least one year of Chess instruction experience.



Preferred Qualifications:

- Ability to work collaboratively with administrators, colleagues, school-based staff, students, parents, and community members.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills.
- Ability to properly maintain confidential information.
- Ability to connect with and motivate students

Salary:

The BSAP Saturday Math Academy Chess Instructor is hired on a yearly basis. The term of service coincides with the academic school year.
