

BSAP Saturday Math Academy Elementary Teachers

Description:

Under the direction of the Black Student Achievement Program (BSAP) Specialist and the BSAP Saturday Math Academy (BSAP SMA) Administrative Team, the teacher facilitates acceleration in mathematics and designs instruction that actively engages all HCPSS students in **grades 3 through 5** over a six-week fall session and/or a six-week spring session. The BSAP SMA teacher provides an atmosphere and environment conducive to the intellectual, physical, social and emotional development of individuals to ensure success for every student. Communicates and interacts with students, parents, staff and the BSAP Saturday Math Academy community. Appropriate maintenance of records and adherence to required procedures and practices are essential. The BSAP SMA teacher monitors appropriate use and care of equipment, materials and facilities.

Position Responsibilities:

- Uses the BSAP SMA curriculum outline provided to develop student-centered lessons that deepen conceptual understanding, provides opportunities for students to engage in collaborative problem solving, productive reasoning and mathematical discourse.
- Provides assistance with home school assignments where requested.
- Participates in collaborative planning to design lessons to meet the needs of all students within the classroom
- Administers formative and summative assessments. Uses data to inform instruction.
- Attends staff meetings and professional learning opportunities.
- Submits one substitute lesson plan per session.
- Maintains student attendance records.
- Provides ongoing feedback to students and parents.
- Completes parent letters at the end of each session and as needed.
- Provides academic, social emotional instruction via virtual learning systems, such as Google Meet and Canvas.
