Policy 8200 Digital Education Policy 9000 Student Residency, Eligibility, Enrollment, and Assignment

On June 6, 2024, the Board adopted modifications to Policy 8200 Digital Education and Policy 9000 Student Residency, Eligibility, Enrollment, and Assignment.

Policy 8200 was modified to update language and definitions within the policy and align the policy with new legislation.

Policy 9000 was modified to add language regarding student reassignment for children of HCPSS employees attending an HCPSS school, allowing them to remain at their current school if the parent/HCPSS employee is involuntarily reassigned to another placement.

The changes are effective immediately. The policies and implementation procedures in their entirety can be accessed on <u>BoardDocs</u> and the <u>HCPSS website</u>.
