Storage of Materials

To: All Staff

Building Services and emergency personnel must have unobstructed access to inspect and maintain equipment. With this fact in mind, all staff are to adhere to the following regulations regarding storage of materials in all HCPSS buildings:

- Combustible materials (paper, cardboard, wood and upholstered furniture) shall not be stored in boiler rooms, mechanical rooms, or electrical rooms. Only non-combustible materials and supplies for the operation and maintenance of the equipment in that room are permitted (National Fire Protection Association Code 10.19.5).
- Construction and installation of shelving in storage areas must have prior approval by the Manager of Building Services and/or the Office of Safety, Environment and Risk Management.
- Obstructions shall not be placed or kept near fire hydrants, fire department inlet connections, or fire protection system controls and valves in a manner that would prevent the equipment from being immediately visible and accessible (National Fire Protection Association Code 13.1.3).
- A minimum clearance space of three feet shall be maintained for any interior fire department valves and equipment. An obstruction or condition that deters or hinders immediate access is strictly prohibited (Howard County Fire Code 13.1.4).
