The Howard County Public School System (HCPSS) is delaying the implementation of the email retention parameters <u>announced on April 18, 2018</u>. The current maximum retention parameters, detailed below, will continue to be applied to email contained within the below system level email folders in all HCPSS accounts until further notice.

- A. Inbox until deleted by account holder
- B. Sent Items 60 days
- C. Deleted Items 30 days
- D. Junk Email 30 days

Staff members who wish to retain emails they have sent beyond the 60-day window are to follow the steps outlined on the <u>Technology Resources Canvas Community</u>.

Please be aware that all electronic communications are discoverable and must be provided when issued a subpoena by the legal system. Additionally, electronic communications are subject to the Maryland Public Information Act (MPIA), and may be made public for inspection upon request.
