Policy Update

On June 8, 2017, the Superintendent provided to the Board modified implementation procedures to the following policies:

- Policy 9090 Wellness Through Nutrition and Physical Activity
- Policy 9230 Alcohol, Other Drugs, Prescription Medication and Over the Counter Products
- Policy 9270 Student Assault and/or Battery on Staff

The modification to Policy 9090 adds language regarding food and beverage advertising and marketing. The modification can be found in section V.G.

The modification to Policy 9230 adds “imminent threat of serious harm”; it alters the penalty for a third offense for possession/use and a first offense for intent to distribute. This modification can be found in sections I. and V.

The modification to Policy 9270 adds “imminent threat of serious harm” and alters the penalty for Battery II offenses. The modification can be found in section IV.
