Policy Update Policy 9000 Student Residency, Eligibility, Enrollment and Assignment

On June 13, 2019, the Board of Education adopted modifications to Policy 9000 Student Residency, Eligibility, Enrollment and Assignment. The policy was modified to allow a nonresident student who is the child of a non-school-based employee the ability to be enrolled into a school within a prescribed feeder pattern cluster, upon payment of tuition. The modification to the implementation procedures updates general enrollment procedures to align with HCPSS current best practices.

Secondly, on June 13, 2019, the Board of Education approved a request to temporarily suspend electronic registration for public hearings in 2019 regarding the redistricting process only (Policy 2040 Public Participation in Meetings of the Board, Section IV.C.5.). During the redistricting process, individuals who would like to speak at a public hearing would have to call the Board Office to register.
